

I CAN REMEMBER WHERE YOU LIKE THE DRIVER'S SEAT AND MORE.

I'm just as eager for a fun drive as you are. To help you hit the road in safety and comfort a bit more quickly, I offer available memory features' for the eight-way power driver's seat and outside mirrors.

This comes in handy if you're not the only person who drives me. With my available memory features, you can set adjustments for the position of the driver's seat and outside mirrors for two drivers. Here's how it works:

- Adjust my driver's seat and outside mirrors to the desired positions.
- Turn my ignition on and then press and release the Set button on my driver's door panel; a beep will sound.
- Then immediately press and hold 1, 2, or B (Exit) until two beeps sound.

These memory settings are tied to the two original key fobs, so I'll adjust to accommodate that person when you turn on my ignition or put me in accessory mode. If you're Driver One, be sure to use the Driver One key fob, because that's the only way I can remember you. After all, I'm a car.

That's all a long way of saying that with my available memory features, two drivers can feel like I'm tailored just to them. It's awesome of you to share, by the way. Now, let's ride!


