The Chevy Camaro's not gone, but the next one will be very different



Mark Phelan, Detroit Free Press I come not to bury the Chevrolet Camaro. Nobody should, really. Reports of the Camaro's death are exaggerated, as General Motors prepares to mothball the sporty car - again - following the 2024model year. The Camaro will be back, but the familiar nameplate is likely to return on a vehicle very different from the V8 coupe and convertible Chevy sells today. Brand boss Scott Bell virtually said as much this week: "This is not the end of Camaro's story." Unlike Ford, which has devotedly kept the Mustang nameplate in continuous production since 1964, Chevrolet treats the Camaro not like it was made of glass, but as if it were in a case labeled "Break glass in case of Mustang." Chevy built the Camaro from 1966 through 2002, then let the nameplate lie fallow until the fifth generation went on sale in 2009 as a 2010 model.

GM has sold 875,000 Camaros since 2009. Sales have slipped in recent years, but a sporty vehicle with a familiar name and design could fit nicely into GM's future lineup of electric vehicles.
