
### THE CORNER CAMARO

This month's Corner Camaro goes to Mark Girimont, EMCC member #28 and his 1974 Z28/LT. Here's Mark's story - I'm the original owner of my  $1\overline{9}74$  Z/28 Type LT. August 2nd this year we will celebrate 50 wonderful years together. I will be passing it down to my son, Nick, as a family legacy. I have done almost all the work on the car myself, however, in 2016 I decided more horsepower was an upgrade I needed. I found an engine shop I trusted to do the job. The original engine block and crankshaft remain but everything else was balanced, blueprinted and a full roller upgrade was installed. On top is an under hood Weiand supercharger, making over 500 horsepower. After I got the engine done, I went to work. Front brakes upgraded to drilled and slotted rotors with Wilwood red calipers. Completely rebuilt the rear brakes and added SS braided brake lines all around. Finally, subframe connectors and new Polyurethane body bushings installed. Thanks for letting me brag. 


