THE CORNER CAMARO

Our next Corner Camaro goes to Duane McDonald, life member #4 and owner of Saturn Printing in Livonia. He has supported EMCC since day one! Thanks! Duane's Camaro is a 1979 Z28 with some modifications. Here's his story-

I have a 1979 Z28 Camaro. I purchased it from Lou LaRiche Chevrolet Plymouth in August 1978. It arrived in October of that same year and I was 18 years old. The Z28 was white with the red/orange striping, which has not changed. T-tops were the new thing to have and my Camaro had them! The interior is mostly white and the powertrain was a \$\bar{3}50\$ engine and auto trans. After the car was one year old and out of warranty is when I began the first of many modifications. To this day there is not much factory items left in the car. The interior is redone in velour in Burgundy and silver. Crager wheels and bigger rear tires were first. Then the engine received a B&M low blower with Webber side-daft carbs, steel braided hoses and Hooker headers. The headers hooked up to chrome side pipes. My Camaro Z28 has not been driven much over the years and some work needs to be done to bring it back to being roadworthy. I met Barry in 1980 and joined the Camaro Club Of Michigan and we've been friends ever since. When CCOM split in membership, I went with the new club and was one of the founding 5 members of the Eastern Michigan Camaro Club! Joining the Camaro Club was a great experience, sharing similar interests with fellow members. I enjoyed all the outings and the camaraderie that goes along with being a member. Although I don't participate as much as I did, I still follow along with the group and try to help when I can. I thank Barry and everyone for allowing me to be a member. CAMARO HISTORY!




