This months' Corner Camaro is EMCC member Jen Sievert's 2017 Camaro 2SS. I'm honored to be featured in the Hugger. I've loved Camaros since high school, and in late 2015 I had decided it was time to work on the bucket list, because "you only live once." I went to the dealership on April 22, 2016, thinking I was going to order a 2016. But the 2017 order codes were available, so I ordered a 2017. It's a Silver Ice Metallic 2SS with the 6.2L LT1 V8 paired with a 6 spd manual transmission. I optioned it with Magnetic Ride Control, body color GM ground effects package, sunroof, black bow ties, red fender hashes, performance exhaust, and the 20" 5 spoke low-gloss black wheels. GM pulled my order the week of May 22nd, built it the week of June 20th, and my invoice and VIN arrived to my e-mail from my sales guy on June 24th. I picked it up July 16th. Whew! That was a long wait! I've made only a few subtle visual modifications by changing the lower front grille, painting the engine cover red and silver, adding ghosted LED side markers, GM blacked out taillights and third brake light, and adding some red to the hood heat extractors. That's about all there is to it. It's an amazing car, and I love, love, love driving it. Great Camaro Jen!! Thanks for being an EMCC member!!
